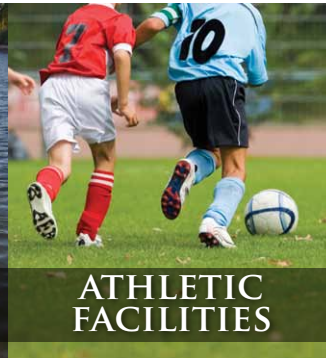


PARKS & TRAILS

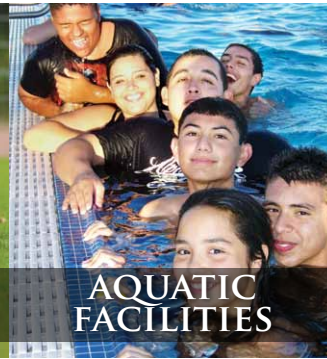
Bike Trails Connecting the Community

In the past decade, Yuma has built seven miles of paved, lit, and landscaped bike trails. Bike along Yuma's riverfront from West Wetlands to Gateway Park, or bike along the East Main Canal from 1st to 40th Street, right through the heart of the City.

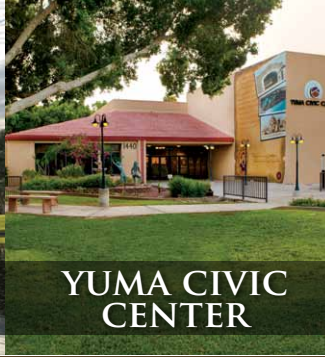
Desert Hills Par 3

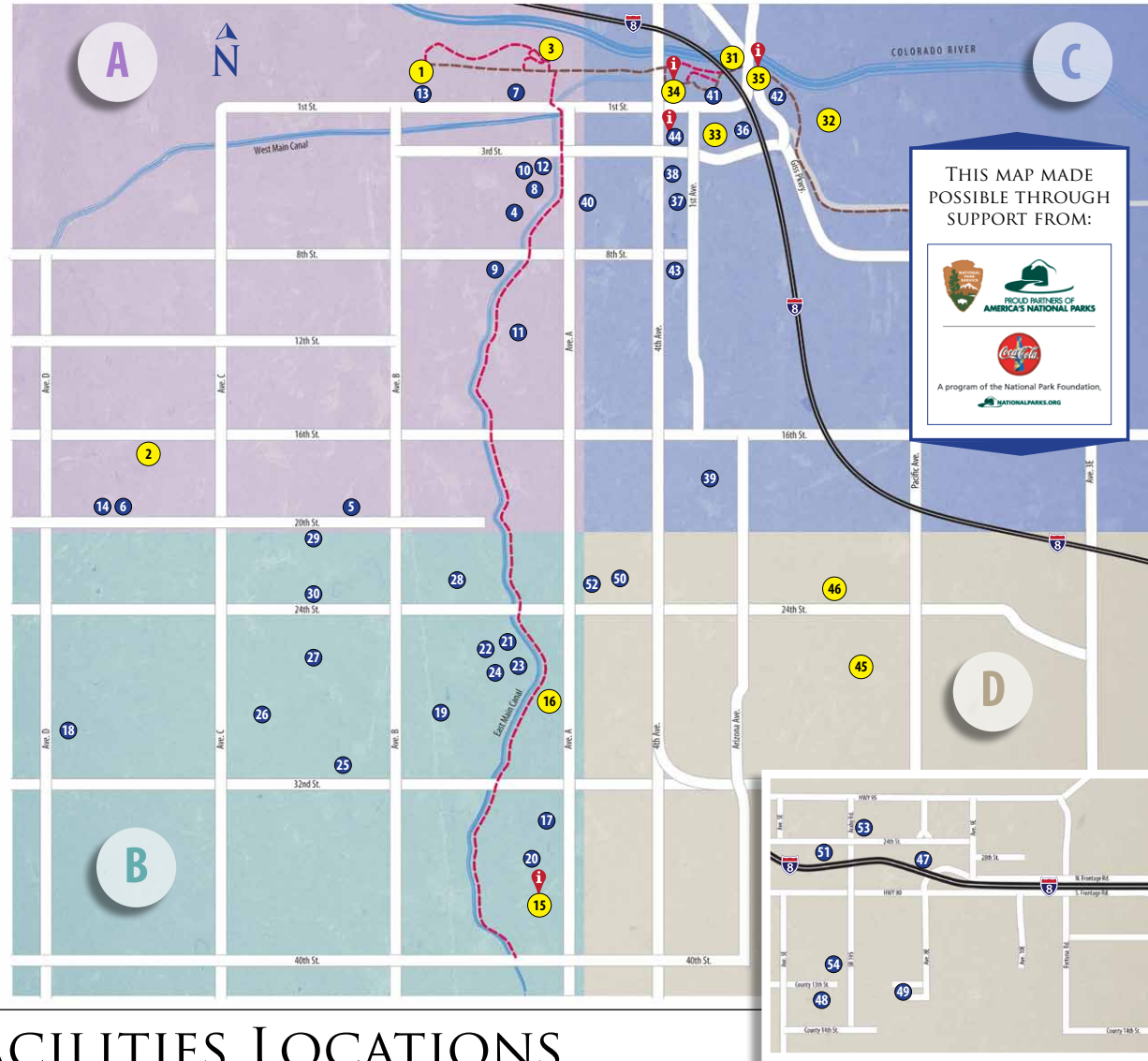
